It is important that any dog learn to walk beside its owner on a loose lead, neither pulling ahead nor lagging behind. 5. Respond to the word "No"- The word "No" is one word that all dogs must learn. This is probably the first command in puppy training to teach your puppy. Once your puppy learns it, you will have far less dog problems to cope with. Slowly they will start responding to these commands and training exercises that follow. Dogs are challenging pets wherein they can learn many things around you and what you teach them basically. So, keep them updated with all the new things. Have fun with your dog and teach them lots of languages too. And of course, by providing basics dog training your dog can become a better family companion, especially in households where there are young children.
