To a first time buyer, sorting out an antique reproduction from an antique original may not be an easy task. Original antique collection generally has some flaws in it. Some wear and tear may show up, but that are again signs of originality. There is a high possibility that a flawless antique item may actually be a reproduced one. You should be extra cautious if you are buying an antique item online. You can easily be duped by those mini-size photographs taken from one or two angles. The photographs may not catch any flaw at all. The picture that catches your attention on the screen may not do so when the real thing is in front of you. So buying any antique item online, ask for more details of the items. Request for more photographs of the item. If you are satisfied, then proceed. However, it is always better to take a note of the reliability of the portal. Antiques are items that need special care and attention. So while buying any such item, first gather information about its storage preservation methods. Generally antiques items are kept in moderately humid and cool places. Exposure to direct sunlight is best avoided. They ought to be handled carefully and with soft hands. If you are a first-time buyer, don't rush to the antique store as if you are buying a T-shirt.
